"...I desire to call your attention to the work [Aiton?] is doing in my cellar. Mr. [?] went down with me today and can tell you about it--The work is very unsatisfactory and I can see no way to mend it except to take it all out--They have not done one particle of grouting but simply plastered the broken stone over with a very poor quality of mortar--I told the men to have Mr Aiton see you before doing any more and must request that yr will see they do the work according to contra or they will get not money for their work."
