Has received \$6,000 from a man in Boston to pay ocean freight for 2000 tons of flour. Ambassador Page has agreed to receive, trans-ship and deliver our cargo to the Belgian minister in Brussels and Edgar has personally solicited the contributions of the Minneapolis millers who, within twenty-four hours, subscribed approximately 7000 barrels of flour, valued at more than \$30,000."
