Hill to Messrs. Clark & Bill, Bismarck

"The morning I left Bismarck I [saw Mr.] Smith who had ploughed for Jackman [&?] Proctor... and he claimed some money. I gave him an order asking you to pay him as I was informed that you had already paid him something out of the store and I had also asked you to pay the party who done [sic] Proctor's ploughing."
