Senator Carter has introduced a bill to open a very small part of the Reservation of the Blackfeet Indians. The whole reservation embraces about 1,600,000 acres while the area to be opened contains only 270,000 acres. The object of the bill is to afford water for the lands of the Conrad Investment Co."
