In 1864, Blanchard was secretary and treasurer of the North Western Packet Co. On April 1, 1866 he became a co-partner of J.J.Hill's and Wellington's in a firm to be known as J.J.Hill Co. Blanchard later held stock in the Winnapeg and Western Transportation Co. Limited. Hill, at this time [1880] owned most of the stock
