

Blanchard, George A.

In 1864, Blanchard was secretary and treasurer of the North Western Packet Co. On April 1, 1866 he became a co-partner of J.J.Hill's and Wellington's in a firm to be known as J.J.Hill Co. The business was to be carried on in St. Paul and the firm was to last from April 1, 1866 to March 31, 1869. See: Articles of Agreement between Blanchard, Wellington and Hill, April 1, 1866.

Blanchard later held stock in the Winnipeg and Western Transportation Co. Limited. Hill, at this time [1880] owned most of the stock
