When this company were to build a smelter at Great Falls, Montana, on land obtained from the Great Falls Water Power & Town Site Co., a dummy company was formed under the name of the United States Land & Water Power Co. It lasted only 2 yrs. or so, but it went through all the usual motions of incorporation, keeping books apart from the Gt. Falls W.P. & T.S. Co., etc. There are among its records: a journal(1888); a stock ledger; stock certificates; cash book(1890); &c. These volumes have few entries. There are also loose papers, now filed with the parent company:
