Papers 1 box, 3 half-boxes Brackett owned land and buildings at First Ave. and 2nd St. So., Minneapolis, which he mortgaged to Hill in 1886 (via E. T. Nichols on occasion). Foreclosure came about Sept., 1894, after Brackett went into bankruptcy. The Wyman Partridge Building on the property burned in November, 1904 There was another bad fire in 1912. The papers deal with the minutiae of mortgages, inventories, revenue and expenses, leases and other contracts, power and heat furnished by Hill after he began to run the property. After Hill's death the property passed to United Securities. Filed with Hill's Real tate section
