Hill to Sir Wilfred Laurier, Prime Minister

Re route of railroad being built by us, the only practical one west of the Okanogan River, up the valley of the Semilkameen to the foot of the mountains. Ore will reach the smelter at Midway and Grand Forks. No other line would serve either the public or those who invest their money in the enterprise. Men are now at work in upper end of Semilkameen Valley & we are also building eastward from the west end."
