Browne was J.J. Hill's representative in the several coal, land, railroad, and other properties in which he had extensive investments in Iowa, along with several of his friends: George Stephen, Donald A. Smith, R.B. Angus, Samuel Thorne, John S. Kennedy, and D. Willis James. He carried on an extensive correspondence with Hill and Hill's secretaries (usually presidents of the Iowa companies) and friends. See
