Carbon. Hill to Bull.

Discusses the changed attitude of the [Oregon Railroad and] Navigation Company. States: "of course if we should be compelled to build a line, which I hope will not be the case, the investment on our part would be comparatively small to give us access to all the country which we might desire to reach - less than half the capital per mile of the existing roads... I hope there will be no occasion for our building any new mileage to secure business which can be reached over existing lines."
