Rumors are flying around lately about difficulties in the Canadian Pacific Ry. and they appear in our papers here as telegrams from Ottawa and Montreal. Reported that McIntyre and Angus have resigned and have sold their interest. Angus when here yesterday said he had not sold out but admitted that McIntyre would probably retire and he might also but that there was no unfriendly feeling. The bears raided the Stock today and it dropped to 46% with large sales and then Manitoba stock was affected through sympathy and

dropped to 91%. Rumors in the Street also that a large block of Manito' Stock belonging to Canadian parties was about to come on the market.
