"Our Supreme Court I have no doubt is holding up the wheat case until the Supreme Court of the United States decides what is known as the 'Nebraska Case' which has recently been re-argued at the request of the court. The case is evidently a close one and was decided by Judge Brewer in favor of the Railways, in the Circuit Court. I am expecting to hear by cable from London the result of to-day's meeting. My letter from there indicate more or less friction between the Broad St. Office & the N.P. Office upstairs in the Mills Bldg; but I have made the case very strong to Mr. Stephen & Gwinner &

hope there will be no further delay."
