Re your letter to Armstrong re ties. "We have put a man from Anoka at work on the line west of Long Lake; he commenced on Monday & is putting out 1000 ties a day now, many of which have to be hauled thro' the woods three miles. As we understand it there is a much better chance on the Lake to get ties, and unless the parties down there can do very much better than you talk we will have to put a crew of our own in there, however we would prefer to give the settlers the chance if they want it and decide soon.
