Can. Pac. Road matters. "Mr. Stephen informs me they [Bank of Montreal?] have agreed to wind up and settle with the members of the Syndicate on the members giving them a guarantee that in the event of the Land Co. not taking the bonds sold to them by the Syndicate, according to contract, the members of the Syndicate will reimburse the Bank of Montreal and take the bonds. Re Manitoba South Western Road stock transferred to me in trust but "as I was a Director of the C.P. Ry. Co. it would be better for prudential reasons to have it put in the name of someone else... the object in view is not to let it become known

that the C.P. Ry. Co. has any interest in the purchase."
