On March 12, 1912 J.J.Hill subscribed \$50,000 to a fund of \$300,000 for endowment for the College of Montana, to be completed December 31, 1913. Hill extended the time limit to December, 1914 and again to 1915, which he stated was final. Apparently the college could not raise the money.
