Telegram. J.J.Hill to Baron Constant

Asks the Baron to be his guest while in St. Paul on the lecture tour. Baron d'Estournelles de Constant was an active member of the Hague Conferences of 1899 and 1907. Attached is a brochure stating that Baron d'Estournelles de Constant "will tell of just what was done at the two World's Hague Conferences,-despite the diversity of language, race, religion and ideas,-of their long labor, of their difficulties, their achievements (considerable even if imperfect), of the quite unexpected accord of a liberal majority of thirty-two

out of forty-four powers represented, and of
the admirable final effort of all to attain
the next stage of progress."
