H. M. Creel to Hill

Describes the situation of his cousin, Creel, one of the richest men in Mexico and a son-in-law of Gen. Terazos, who captured Diaz many years ago. Creel has been obliged to flee for his life from Mexico City with his family, and Villa is now operating his property. Civil law seems to have been suspended, but Creel does not believe his cousin's property can be confiscated. Asks Hill's aid where possible.
