"I Noticed by the newspapers that the Duluth & Winnipeg Road had been sold under foreclosure and purchased by or in the interest of the Canadian Pacific. I hope notwithstanding this that you have accomplished or will yet succeed in accomplishing what you desired in connection with that property. McKinley's election seems assured.
