J.S. Kennedy to Hill, from Bar Harbor, Maine
Sir Donald Smith came and went (3 weeks from
London to N.Y. & back) without seeing Gov. Gen.
of Canada, who wished to see him. "I Noticed
by the newspapers that the Duluth & Winnipeg
Road had been sold under foreclosure and pur-
chased by or in the interest of the Canadian
Pacific. I hope notwithstanding this that you
have accomplished or will yet succeed in ac-
complishing what you desired in connection
with that property. McKinley's election seems
assured. "McKinley' is not my ideal for a Pres-
ident and I have no sympathy with his tariff
views, but in the present emergency our only
salvation would seem to be in his election."
