JJH to F. L. Brown, N.Y. Duluth and Winnipeg railroad's land grant does not exist, according to Judge Clark, who gave Hill this opinion when the Manitoba railroad started to build from Crookston to Lake Superior over much the same route. Will complete our line this fall, which will leave [swampland] grant involved useless. Judge [Greenileaf] Clark was formerly of Minn. Supreme Court and probably knows more about Minn. swampland grants than anyone else.
