"It is not the intention of this company to extend its lines farther than Hinckley as long as the business between that point and Duluth is done in a satisfactory manner by the St. Paul and Duluth Company. We have let the contract for an elevator at West Superior with a capacity to unload 400 cars per day, and ship on vessels 50,000 bushels an hour, guaranteed. To this we will add a large yard, so as to avoid the delay and consequent damage to business as is now the case through want of room and facilities for the past two seasons."
