There are many letters in the general correspondence from George Durand-Ruel of Paris and New York to Hill re paintings for sale from 1888 to 1892. Among the artists whose paintings Durand-Ruel were offering for sale were Delacroix, Corot, Millet, Rousseau, Meissonier, Courbet, Decamps and Troyons. Many of Hill's most valued paintings came from Durand-Ruel. These letters have been filed by date in General Correspondence.
