John C. Eden to Jno. Toomey.

"The Eastern Railway & Lumber Co is a small logging road running from Centralia about four miles out into timber country. I understand that the owners contemplate extending the road a distance of eight miles from Centralia to some coal fields owned by the company. They have a small mill of about 50,000 feet capacity at Centralia but are planning upon the erection of a larger one."

"The Olympia & [REDACTED] Valley Ry has

been defunct for [redacted] time and it is improbable that anything [redacted] ever come of it."
