Re giving testimony in the Farley suit. We are finding some helping testimony as we go along. Today I found that Mr. Comstock, who was an attorney for Farley in some matters in the Red River Valley, while waiting in Farley's office heard Farley and Fisher discussing and ridiculing the idea of Jim Hill getting anyone to go into such an enterprise as getting the Dutch committee bonds. Kittson is expected here tomorrow. I have been now 12 days on the witness chair. Hope to systematize the staff and office work this summer, when we get into our new offices.
