Hill to George Stephen

Re Gilman's commencement of suits for Sahlgaard and two others and "will seek to have Farley examined by Commission as to what passed between Mr Barnes and Farley in regard to the position of the firm of which Mr Barnes was a member in the purchase of the bonds from the Dutch Com[mittee] also in regard to certain conversations had by Farley with Mr Kennedy... I believe old Farley is quite capable of swearing to anything if he thought it would get him a few dollars....When Angus returns I want to have him [Farley] made to disgorge the money he has stolen while [redacted] ever."
