Re ownership of South St. Paul bank stock by Hill -- wants his interest to continue after his death and proposes to make that arrangement "When ~~thazzarrangement~~ I bought the stock of the First and Second National banks of St. Paul the controlling interest in the first was owned by an estate and its heirs, and of the Second by a woman of middle age living in Washington, D.C. and none of them was doing anything for the banks."
