Hill to W. F. Davidson, Cincinnati

Great detail on the flour and wheat trade that Hill sees for the Mississippi River and its tributaries, listed by mills &c. "The wheat at all points above Hastings that is not bought by your men or Henry Eames will be bought and ground by the mills and I will give you about what the millers estimate they will grind from now until the time they shut down and wait for the new crop." List follows, with figures of estimates of grind, "making in all 74,500 Brls [barrels] to go forward between now and next Harvest."
