Since making the agreement with Edgerton, some parties in Helena have tried to persuade Edgerton to relinquish his lands to them for "a large advance." But "there is now no danger of any additions to the town-site by outside parties," since he has drawn a check for \$1640 on Hill to pay the balance owed Edgerton.
