There is considerable correspondence from August, 1912 to January, 1913 re a loan made by J.J.Hill to Paris Gibson in 1911.

See carbon of letter from [Toomey] to Paris Gibson, January 18, 1913 in which Toomey states:

"The demand note which you gave Mr. James J. Hill, dated March 23, 1911, for \$83,927.97 and the securities held as collateral to same, have this day been surrendered to the First National Bank, St. Paul, f. delivery to the First National Bank of Great Falls, for

your account, Mr. Hill having received payment of the sum of \$65,000.00 as agreed with you to discharge the indebtedness."
