Born in Brownfield, Maine, July 1, 1830. Died Dec. 16, 1920. Graduated Bowdoin College, 1851. Settled in Minneapolis, 1858. Was a close friend of Wm Watts Folwell [see his papers] and of JJH, for whom he acted in Montana matters. He built the first foouring mill in Minneapolis before removing to Fort Benton, Montana in 1879. Interested JJH in founding Great Falls and developing its waterpower at the several falls of the Missouri River there Was a wool buyer for many years at Fort Benton and elsewhere in Montana Terry. Was one of JJH's most pro ?ic correspondents, 1882-1916.

Died December 16, 1920.
