Esler, Helena, Montana, to Hill "I have just closed a deal with some mine owners in the Swift Current copper mining district located in the ceded strip from the Blackfeet indian reservation to mine and concentrate four hundred thousand tons of ore - developments will continue until next spring, if with satisfactory results. I will erect concentrating mills there next season, as I have three years from June 1st 1900 to complete my contract."
