Puts in writing, after interview with Hill in St. Paul, his proposition re Granby Consolidated Mining Smelting & Power Company, Ltd., with listed property and other assets in British Columbia, such as copper mines and smelters, with a statement of how he will spend money if proposed stock is issued and if Hill builds a railroad from Granby Forks, B.C.
