"For your information, and that you may better understand the position of the Great Falls Water Power & Townsite Company, I may state that Mr. Hill's investment in that company has been productive of very little return, and the company for the past eleven years has been barely able to meet its financial obligations and that only after realizing on sales of real estate, or in other words disposing of part of its assets, and the immediate outlook is such that it is a serious question with the

Company to provide funds for maturing obligations. Not only is his investment non-productive, but in a great measure it has devolved upon Mr. Hill to devise ways and means to meet the difficulties encountered both financially and otherwise.

It is the general feeling among those interested in the company that it has assumed more than its share of sacrifices in locating industries and extending favors to institutions of a public nature in the up-building of the City."
