Business & earnings are up, especially Alaskan and general Western business. Weather has been very favorable especially for seeding. The new warehouse at West Superior is nearly finished and has heard that Farrington has chartered his first boat to carry wheat. Track-laying near Carlton is progressing well and the crossing question with Nor.Pac. has been settled. Judge Burke has acquired 1800 additional feet of water front. Stevens intends to go over the Montana Central with Ward and will then spend several days at the tunnel, which is progressing well.
