Hill to C.R. Cummings, Chicago

Gen. Hammond now of St. Paul, "but formerly connected with Villard in his Kansas and Northern Pacific enterprises, has been urging the St. P. & Duluth a number of times in regard to the construction of a line on the south shore of Lake Superior. He has done a good deal of work and claims to have some options... As I understand it, he is representing some Northern Pacific and Grand Trunk interests...
