Re getting James Z. Moore appointed a proposed
judge for a new Washington district east of the
mountains, as against a proposed district giv-
ing choice to Tacoma; He is like Judge Hanford,
who acted so swiftly for railroad interests
during the last strike on Northern Pacific. He
then issued an injunction order restraining
the men from interfering with the property of
the Company, and had all violators taken on the
first train to the peni tinary, and the strike

was ended in a half day's time, without loss of life or property.
