"The 'Globe' is in a very different and, I am glad to say, more favorable condition today than when you were here, eliminating the Silver question entirely. You probably have heard that we not only moved from the Dispatch Building, but have invested nearly \$50,000.00 in a plant that we consider first class in every way, and equal to that of any newspaper in the city. The 'Globe' is at present located in the First Building (formerly the Germania Bank Building) at the

corner of Fifth and Washa Streets, and occupies half the base. It for presses, two rooms on the ground floor for the Business Department, and the whole of the second floor, the front half of the latter for Editorial Rooms and the rear half for Stereotyping and Composing Rooms. Moreover, we have leased the premises in question for a period of five years."
