Has talked with Choate re the Northern Securities Case. Choate feels that the court will permit three counsel on each side -- probably Olney, Johnson, Guthrie, Spooner, Lawrence, and Maxwell.

States that "the case will turn on question of 'conspiracy' in forming the Co. for purpose of controlling Nor Pac & G^t Nor. The question of right of corporate or individual ownership of part or all of share does not enter into

the case, at least so the Atty Gen^l stated."
