Hill, February 1, 1911: "I happened to attend a banquet in honor of your father at Wahpeton, N.D. last fall ... In a speech he said that he started his transportation and traffic business 40 years ago. His steamboat Selkirk left from Fort Abercrombie in the spring of 1871 and went down the Red River. He also mentioned that this voyage made the start of Grand Forks!
