Memorandum of an agreement between James J. Hill and Egbert S. Litchfield, as partners of J.J.Hill and Company, and the First Divisor of the St. Paul & Pacific Road. J.J.Hill and Company will lease the freight depot, docks and yard room from the railroad, until Dec. 31, 1872.
