Hill to Dr. J. W. Fairbanks, St. Paul

(tutor to the Hill boys.)

"Your letters have been received. ~~Yo~~My letter of August 13, 1884 engaged you to take charge of the education of my sons until they were thoroughly prepared for College and fixed the time as five years. Last summer I called you into the library and told you that this was not the result and that it would be better to send the boys away to school," and you agreed. Salary has been \$4,000. Boys are a full year behind now and "their teachers say they do not know how to study and do good work."
