"There seems to be good assurance that the people of Hutchinson ... will vote aide in favor of an extension of the Motor Line, which will be made, outside of the city limits, a standard gauge, to connect with our line, and to run into the Minneapolis Union Depot. We shall then control about all the business at Lake Minnetonka." Re Pioneer Press article attack by [Ignatius?] Donnelly upon Hill and the Manitoba Railway."
