Encloses letter from John Vopni to James Fisher, dated October 10, 1906 which states:  
[The Icelandic Evangelical Lutheran Synod of North America] "was organized in 1855, and at the time of organization, embraced only eleven congregations, scattered throughout Minnesota, North Dakota, and Manitoba, now it includes Forty Congregations, Ten Ministers, over 7000 members and is church property valued about \$100,000. More than two-thirds of the Synod's strength is in Manitoba and

Saskatchewan, where large and growing colonies of Icelanders are located."
