Railroad land grants, July 26, 1890

To Hon. W. F. Sanders, U. S. Senate

Railroad was built without any assistance from the Government. Congressional legislation provided that a commission appointed by the Secretary of the Interior should fix a price upon the right of way through the Indian reservation, which has been done, and the money has been paid to the proper officers of the government.
