"As requested, I submit herewith a brief statement of the consolidation of the electric railway enterprises and power Company of Spokane, Washington. The Company incorporated to take over the different enterprises is the Inland Empire Railway Company, capital of one hundred thousand shares of one hundred dollars each." Five cos. are to be taken over: Spokane Water Power Co.; Spokane Traction Co.; Spokane Terminal Co.; Spokane and Inland Ry (now being built in the Pelouse country); Coeur d'Alene & Spokane Ry., operating from Spokane to Coeur d'Alene Lake.
