"I sometimes think you may be apprehensive that I will provoke some feeling between our friends from Montreal and myself, but of this I beg that you will have no fear. They cannot quarrel with me if they should try, and I want to get our money for the Southwestern before Mr. Kennedy returns... When you are fully aware of the action of the Canadian Pacific towards this Company and to Mr. Kennedy and myself for the past seven months, you will be at least surprised."
