Worked for Hill & Acker in Duluth in 1875 and 1876, apparently in charge of the company's operations there. He wrote letters concerning the business to Hill and Acker almost daily. These letters contain valuable information about the amounts of coal being shipped to various points in the Northwest, about the work and working conditions on the docks, and shipping on the Great Lakes.
