Earnings of road good but as soon as lake at Duluth closes, I fear we shall run short of storage. During past summer storage at Minneapolis was increased 1,000,000 [bushels?] and at Duluth 600,000 and we could easily fill 1,000,000 more at each place. "I have made a sale of Red River Rolling Mills Elevator [Hillsboro] for \$4,000, its full value, and James Tod has made the transfer. He is running the mill in a moderate way. Little chance of selling mill at present. Secombe is at Anoka in charge ~~ZZZZZZZZ~~ of Mille Lacs Lumber Co. to remain until it can be closed out.
