Periodically, in the early 1900's, J.J. Hill attempted to sell his Kittson County lands. A form letter was sent out, usually to real estate men in Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, and Missouri. For example see: Carbon. [John R. Stinson] to S. A. Henry at Red Oak, Iowa, March 10, 1910.
